- 4. Road paving: Washington st. Minimum from Brown Ln to Brook LN. Harold will get. Quote on this project (will obtain a quote for Brown Ln to Brook Ln/and the whole road). Harold will also get an idea of exactly how in-depth this road project will be as there are other issues.
