RESOLUTION NO. 2026-1  
RESOLUTION TO SURRENDER MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITY OF THE WESTON  
SPORTS PROGRAM TO THE WESTON SPORTS INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, the Village of Weston is a Statutory Village located in Wood County, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Weston has powers of local self-government pursuant to Ohio Constitution Article XVIII, Section 3, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Weston operates a Village-wide youth sports program, and

WHEREAS, the Weston Sports Initiative is a tax exempt organization located in Weston, Ohio, EIN 33-3291278, organized to operate the Village youth sports program, and

WHEREAS, prior to 2025, the Village of Weston held, for the benefit of the youth sports program, funds (not taxpayer funds) for use by the Weston Sports Initiative or earlier, informal collection of volunteers to help operate the youth sports program in the Village, and

WHEREAS, in April, 2025, the Weston Sports Initiative and the Village of Weston entered into a Facility Use Agreement for use by the Weston Sports Initiative of Village-owned parks and facilities for sporting events, with the intention of taking over control of the Village youth sports program, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Weston presently holds funds (not taxpayer funds) for the benefit of the Weston Sports Initiative, and desires to release said funds to the Weston Sports Initiative, to be used in furtherance of its charitable purpose, and further desires to separate itself from the Weston Sports Initiative, excepting the aforementioned Facility Use Agreement, as it may be amended or extended by mutual agreement, relinquishing control of the youth sports program to the Weston Sports Initiative.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Weston, Wood County, Ohio:


Section 1. The Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to spend, in a manner determined by the Weston Sports Initiative, the balance of those funds raised by the Weston Sports Initiative or by an earlier organized, informal collection of volunteers before or after the Weston Sports Initiative's formal organization, presently held by the Village of Weston for the benefit of the youth sports program and to be used by the Weston Sports Initiative in furtherance of its charitable purpose.

Section 2. Upon the exhaustion of the aforementioned funds the Village Fiscal Officer shall close out the fund and the Village shall thereby surrender all authority to manage or oversee the management of the youth sports program to the Weston Sports Initiative, subject only to the Facility Use Agreement between the parties, as it may be amended or extended by mutual agreement.




