ORDINANCE NO. 2024-15 VILLAGE OF WESTON, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO

ORDINANCE AWARDING PROJECT CONTRACT, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Weston is a statutory village located in Wood County, Ohio, with powers of local self-government pursuant to Ohio Constitution Article XVIII, Section 3, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Weston through FellerFinch & Associates, Inc. (the Engineer) created bid specifications and published request for bids to perform certain work known as Main Street Road Improvement Project, (the Project), and

WHEREAS, the Engineer considered all timely submitted bids for the Project and has made its recommendation for the lowest and best contractor to complete the Project, and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has reviewed the bid proposal and corresponding agreement proposal and has agreed to approve the recommendation of its engineer and award the contract for the Project.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTON, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

1. The Village accepts the Engineer's recommended contractor for the Main Street Road Improvement Project, (the Project), and Morlock Asphalt, Ltd. is hereby awarded the contract to perform the Project, as set forth in the engineer's specifications, a notice of award, and in the agreement for the Project, in the amount set forth in the notice of award and the agreement.
2. The Mayor and/or Village Administrator is hereby authorized to sign a notice of award and to enter into an agreement on behalf of the Village of Weston for the Project, as outlined in the Village engineer's specifications, and that such notice of award and agreement are hereby approved.
3. The Mayor and/or Village Administrator is hereby authorized to sign all documents necessary to secure the financing for the Project, if any, and the same is hereby approved.
4. This measure is an emergency measure necessary to the health and safety of the Village and its residents for the reason that the Village's Main Street is in need of immediate care, the contractor is available to perform the work forthwith, and three readings of this Ordinance would delay the project and potentially result in additional costs and expenses. Further, the health of the Village's streets is essential to the health and safety of the community.
5. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any other committees that results in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


