ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING STOP INTERSECTIONS IN THE VILLAGE OF WESTON, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Ordinance No. 2023-4 Passed March 6, 2023

SECTION 2: That after the effective date of this ordinance, the following intersections are designated as yield intersections:

Yield Street

Elementary Park at
Alumni Park at

Thru Street

Broadway Street
Locust Street

SECTION 3: All vehicles entering any streets from an alley shall stop and such intersections shall be designated as stop intersections and stop signs installed therein.

SECTION 4: Except when directed to proceed by a law enforcement officer, every driver of a vehicle or trackless trolley approaching a stop sign shall stop at a clearly marked stop line, but if none, before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection, or, if none, then at the point nearest the intersecting roadway where the driver has a view of approaching traffic on the intersecting roadway before entering it. After having stopped, the driver shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicle in the intersection or approaching on another roadway so closely as to constitute an immediate hazard during the time the driver is moving across or within the intersection or junction of roadways.

SECTION 5: Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. If, within one year of the offense, the offender previously has been convicted of or pleaded guilty to one predicate motor vehicle or traffic offense, whoever violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree. If, within one year of the offense, the offender previously has been convicted of two or more predicate motor vehicle or traffic offenses, whoever violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree.

SECTION 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7: This measure is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the village and its residents for the reason that an additional stop intersection is necessary for safety.
