ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE
(Revised Code Sec. 5705.38)

ORDINANCE PROVIDING PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT
EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES FOR THE VILLAGE OF WESTON,
OHIO, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2026

WHEREAS, the Village of Weston is a statutory village located in Wood County, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Weston has powers of local self-government pursuant to Ohio
Constitution Article XVIII, Section 3, and the Ohio Revised Code, and

WHEREAS, Council has considered certain permanent appropriations for 2026 in order to meet
obligations of the Village and to authorize certain other expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Weston, Wood
County, Ohio, that:

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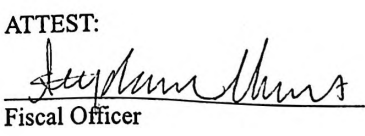

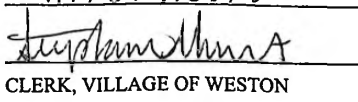
