

**VILLAGE OF WESTON, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO
ORDINANCE 2022-8**

**AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO ADVANCE MONIES FROM THE
GENERAL FUND TO THE RECENTLY CREATED ODNR RESERVOIR RESTORATION CAPITAL
PROJECT FUND, TO RETURN AN EQUIVALENT SUM TO THE GENERAL FUND AFTER GRANT
FUNDING, TO AMEND APPROPRIATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Weston is a statutory village located in Wood County, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Weston has powers of Local Self Government pursuant to Article XVIII, Section 3 of the Ohio Constitution and

WHEREAS, the Village of Weston has received approval for grant monies from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) to complete capital improvements to the Village reservoir, and requires the opening of a separate fund to receive and expend monies related thereto, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Weston adopted Ordinance 2022-6, by emergency, which authorized and directed the Fiscal Officer to create the ODNR Reservoir Restoration Capital Project Fund (4905) and establish appropriations for the purpose of segregating ODNR grant funds for the restoration of the Village reservoir, and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned ODNR grant is a reimbursing grant, requiring the Village to advance an amount equal to the anticipated ODNR grant funds from the Village General Fund to the ODNR Reservoir Restoration Capital Project Fund (4905) and returning to the General Fund such grant monies upon receipt by the Village from ODNR. The earlier Ordinance did not consider these transfers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTON, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to Advance-Out \$29,400 from the Village General Fund to the ODNR Reservoir Restoration Capital Project Fund (4905) for the purpose of advance funding the anticipated grant monies from ODNR.

SECTION 2. The Fiscal Officer, upon receipt of the ODNR grant monies, is hereby authorized to accept said grant monies and to Advance-Out said monies, in the amount of \$29,400, from the ODNR Reservoir Restoration Capital Project Fund (4905) to the Village General Fund.

SECTION 3. This measure is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the Village and its residents for the reason that accounting rules require the creation of said Fund at the time of the receipt of such monies, and receipt of the monies is anticipated forthwith.

SECTION 4. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Revised Code of Ohio.
