## WESTON, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO RESOLUTION NO. 2026-2

### RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR FINANCING AND ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS RELATED TO THE FINANCING AND LEASE/PURCHASE OF AN AMBULANCE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Weston is a Statutory Village located in Wood County, Ohio, with powers of local self-government pursuant to Ohio Constitution Article XVIII, section 3, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Weston provides emergency medical services to residents located within and without the Village (EMS), and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Weston has determined the need for a new ambulance for EMS, and has approved the purchase of an ambulance, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village desires to borrow funds to finance the costs associated with the lease/purchase of said ambulance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the Village of Weston, Ohio, that:

1. The Council of the Village of Weston hereby approves the financing and lease/purchase of a new ambulance.

2. The Council of the Village of Weston authorizes the Village Administrator, Mayor and/or Fiscal Officer to make an application to borrow an amount not to exceed \$300,000.00 to pay costs associated with the lease/purchase of an ambulance, (the Loan).

3. The Council of the Village of Weston authorizes the Village Administrator, Mayor and/or the Fiscal Officer to complete and execute, on behalf of the Village of Weston, any documents necessary to secure said funding, and to bind the Village, accordingly, and to deliver any necessary documents on behalf of the Village.

4. Lease and/or purchase expenses and repayment of the Loan is approved to be made from a newly established Village fund, to be determined by the Village Council, or such other funds as determined by Council.

5. This measure is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the village and its residents for the reason that a new ambulance is critical to the efficient provision of emergency medical services, and loan funding is a necessary component of the lease/purchase of said ambulance. To proceed with the funding and complete the lease/purchase forthwith, the funds must be in place.


