ORDINANCE TO AMEND 2021 APPROPRIATIONS FOR STREET MAINTENANCE AND REPAIRS AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF WESTON, STATE OF OHIO DURING THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2021 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Weston, Ohio, Wood County:

SECTION 1: The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to increase the 2021 permanent appropriations in the Streets Construction - Maintenance/Repairs (2011) Capital Outlay-Streets, Highways, Sidewalks and Curbs (800-555-0000) for current expenses by \$13,642.00.

SECTION 4: That the council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with acceptable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the Village to meet its financial obligations in a timely manner, and therefore shall go into immediate effect upon passage.
