

ORDINANCE TO AMEND 2021 APPROPRIATIONS BY ESTABLISHING APPROPRIATIONS FOR FUND 2151 2020 CRF (CORONA RELIEF FUND) EXPENSES FOR THE VILLAGE OF WESTON, STATE OF OHIO DURING THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2021 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2021 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**Whereas**, the Federal Government has created CARESACT, in which grant money, known as CRF, for all Local Governments to fight and prevail during the COVID Pandemic.

**Whereas**, to use the CRF is to be expended through the Office of the Fiscal Officer, who has been ordered to create a New Fund to track and expend all CRF received.

**Whereas**, the new fund shall be appropriated and certified with the Wood County Auditor before any use of the CRF can be allowed.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Weston, Ohio, Wood County:

**SECTION 1:** The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to increase the 2021 permanent appropriations in fund 2151- CRF Fund by Program code to cover expenses incurred by the COVID- 19 pandemic
