- Reviewed letter to property owners regarding Sycamore project. The letter from Paul Skaff was revised and the committee agreed it used the revised version.
- Still Waiting on OPWC. SIB loan 10 years with annual payment not exceed \$50,000
- Washington St: Discussed catch basin and problems regarding drainage in the area. Plan to clean the catch basin near Brown Lane. Will look into drainage issues and the line to the ditch and possible solutions to solve the flooding in that area. Harold will have Camtech look into drainage. Committee has agreed Washington St needs repaving but will wait until next PW meeting to discuss drainage issues before bringing to council to approve repaving of Washington St. (\$23,400.00). Concerns over the thickness of the current road were raised, Harold will investigate more.
- Will invite Bob Desmond to the next Public Works meeting to discuss any updates in sidewalk projects
- Discussed widening turn area at Oak and Silver St. Discussed putting in stone and adding concrete to the area.
